Letter to Bishop Wypych

Candidates for Confirmation must submit a typed letter to Bishop Wypych by the deadline established. Please take the time to carefully compose your letter. Letters must be written by the student.

Include these points in your typed letter:

- 1. Address your letter "Dear Bishop Wypych"
- 2. Introduce yourself: give your full name (first, middle and last name), high school attending and that you are a Candidate for Confirmation
- 3. Explain the reasons you want to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- 4. Confirmation is the affirmation of your Baptism and the commitment to live the Gospel and spread the Gospel message. Give a couple of examples of how you plan to live as a disciple after Confirmation.
- 5. Mention the saint name you have selected for Confirmation and why you have chosen this saint.
- 6. Mention one aspect of your faith that you have learned more about during your time of preparation for Confirmation. Explain why this is important.
- 7. Describe how you have been actively involved with serving others. How have your service projects changed you?
- 8. Mention your sponsor by name and the reason you selected your Confirmation sponsor.
- 9. End the letter "Sincerely," and sign your first and last name by hand.
- 10. Check your spelling! Have someone proofread your letter and correct any mistakes.
